To ensure entire school coverage for this assignment, you will each receive the name of your interview subject/ topic. To complete this assignment you should follow the following 6-Step Process:

- 1. Decide an angle and subject(s) for your story.
- 2. Develop a minimum of 5 interview questions.- email these in.
- 3. Email your subject a message requesting their help with your interview for this class assignment and the questions.
- 4. Write a story (around 200 words) that incorporates their answers using both summaries and direct quotes.
- 5. Take 1 picture to go along with your story. This can either be of the interview subject or events surrounding your story, or even a google image relating to your topic.
- 6. Submit the article by emailing **both** the article and pictures to Shelton. (These can be added to your previously shared list of questions if that is more convenient.)
