#### Haunting of Hill House Background

- Genre: Psychological Ghost Story
  Not the traditional grotesque style of Poe
- Author: Shirley Jackson (1916-1965)
- Published: 1959
- Tone of Works: Impending sense of doom framed by ordinary settings and characters
- Considered to be a major influential writer on Stephen King

## Psychological Ghost Story

- Dissolving boundary between the mind and the exterior world
- About the puzzle of identity AND about its madness
- Basically, this is an extension of the Brooding Romantics (gothic's) that we studied last year

#### Author's Style/ Background

- Jackson "often wrote about solitary, mousy young women"
- While she wrote about "spooky isolation" she was actually from a large family
- Mommy issues
  - Considered to be plain, eccentric, ungainly
  - Most of her characters conflict with their mother/ feel isolated because of it

#### Main Characters

- I. Eleanor Vance
  Vulnerable, lonely, plagued by burdens of not being wanted
- 2. Dr. Montague
  - Requests participants for his "experiment" at Hill House
- 3. Theodora
- Opposite of Eleanor
- 4. Luke Sanderson
  - Related to the owner of Hill House
